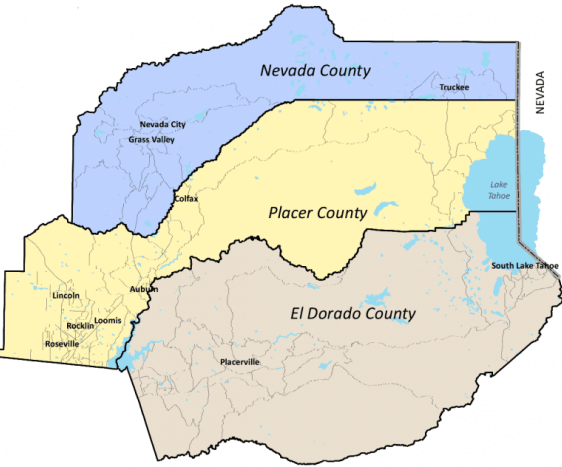
Our Commitment

Feeding the Foothills leads the fight against hunger in El Dorado, Nevada, and Placer counties by providing healthy food, partnering with local organizations, and empowering communities through education, advocacy, and compassion.



Feeding the Foothills is one of only 200 food banks nationwide to be a certified member of Feeding America, the nation's leading domestic hunger-relief organization.

Our Service Region



As a Feeding America food bank, Feeding the Foothills supports a three-county region with a total population of nearly 700K residents. Clients are typically employed families, but a high cost of living and increased grocery prices mean residents struggle to bridge the meal gap. We help bridge that gap by bringing together donors, sponsors, retail partners, hunger relief agencies, and community fundraisers.



Hidden Hunger

Hunger in the foothills doesn't always look like empty cupboards. Sometimes it's a family stretching canned goods for another week, or a senior skipping meals to pay for medicine. In rural areas, fewer resources and long travel distances make food access harder than ever.
